Thank you for choosing the Portland Baseball Club Classic. We are committed to making this a top notch event every year and your participation is very much appreciated.

The Portland Baseball Club Classic features the top teams from the Northwest. The round robin tournament format is exciting for all teams involved as each game is crucial to advancing into the championship games. All games are played with aluminum bats and are 7 innings with a two hour time limit. We use speed up rules between innings to keep the game moving along and make the action exciting for the spectators. All tournament games are umpired with high school and college experienced umpires from the Portland Baseball Umpires Association.

Most of the tournament games are held at Clackamas Community College, the summer home of Portland Baseball Club. Clackamas CC features a spacious field with great dimensions. We have two outdoor cages that are available throughout the tournament and large grass areas around the complex for practices and warmups. There is ample bleacher style seating at the field as well as a concession stand and press box. Other sites that may be used during the tournament include Mt. Hood Community College and Aloha High School.

The Portland area features many great tourist attractions. Our host hotel, The Courtyard by Marriott in Clackamas, is within walking distance from Clackamas Town Center Shopping Mall. The mall features numerous restaurants and a 20 screen movie theater. Other great local attractions include Bridgeport Village Shopping Center, the Portland Saturday Market, NW 23rd shopping and restaurants, and Players Bowling and Entertainment.

We are excited to host the 2010 Portland Baseball Club Classic and look forward to making this a great event.

# PORTLAND BASEBALL CLUB CLASSIC

## Tournament Rules

- Metal bats conforming to high school and college specifications will be used for all tournament games.
- All games are to be played to a 2 hour time limit and are 7 inning games. If an inning is started before the time limit expires, that inning will be completed. No new inning will be start after 2 hours.
- For games ending in a tie, 2 additional innings will be played to make it a 9 inning game. If the game is tied after 9 innings, then the game ends a tie.
- A 10-run rule is in effect after 5 innings.
- The home and visiting teams are listed on the schedule. Portland Baseball Club will always be in the third base dugout. On Sunday, the home team will be determined by a coin toss from the tournament director in the presence of both head coaches.
- No pre-game infield practice is allowed for any game. The batting cages will be available for all teams. Please take ground balls and fly balls in the outfield.
- The gate will open 90 minutes before the first game of the day.
- All games will be played under National League rules with the American League designated hitter rule. Any of the nine starting players may withdraw and re-enter once provided such player occupies the same batting position whenever he is in the line-up. A substitute who is withdrawn may not re-enter, except for injury or ejection.
- Speed up rules will be applied and enforced by the umpires:
  - 1) Each team will receive 1 minute between innings. Penalty: ball or strike for the batter.
  - 2) 25 seconds between pitches. Penalty: ball or strike for the batter.
  - 3) After each out, the ball will be returned immediately to the pitcher. Throwdowns between innings will be allowed, but not after strike outs or putouts. Penalty: ball for the next batter.
  - 4) Courtesy runners for catchers only mandatory with 2 outs.
- Decisions made by umpires on the field are final. No protests will be allowed.
- Tiebreaker for pool standings:
  - 1) Win-Loss record
  - 2) Fewest runs allowed
  - 3) Most runs scored
  - 4) Head to Head (Not applicable if 3 team tie remaining)
  - 5) Coin toss
- Portland Baseball Club strives to put on a first class event. The tournament director may disqualify any player, coach, or fan for the remainder of the tournament who displays unsportsmanlike conduct or willfully violates tournament or field rules. Any coach or player ejected from a game must leave the field at that time and will be ineligible for the next game, unless overruled by the tournament director. If this individual does not leave the field, the team is subject to forfeiture.

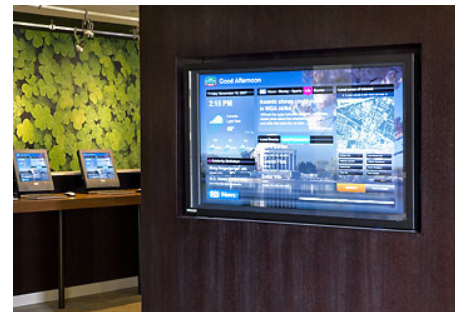

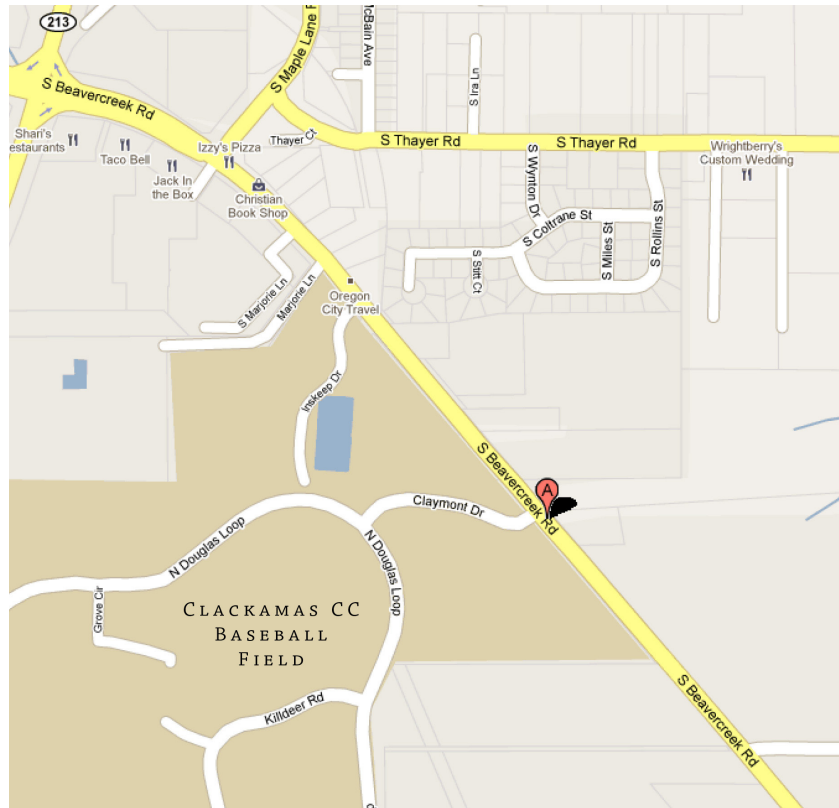

**Directions to Clackamas Community College:**

Take I205 to Exit 10 for State Route 213 South towards Oregon City/Molalla.

Follow OR-213 South for about 3.5 miles.

Turn Left at South Beaver Creek Rd. Stay in Right Lane.

Right Lane becomes right turn only into the college at Claymont Dr.

Turn Left at North Douglas Loop and the field is in front of you.
