Portland Baseball Club is proud to offer its third year of the wood bat Portland Baseball Club Fall League. The PBC league features doubleheaders played every Sunday at the top high school and college baseball fields in Oregon and SW Washington. The 2010 league featured 12 teams in our high school division and 9 teams in our junior high school division. We look forward to expanding in 2011 and maintaining the highest quality of competition and organization.

The 2011 PBC Fall League will also offer a special training program for players signing up as individuals. See the next page for more information on our weekly training program.

Advantages to playing in the Portland Baseball Club Fall League include:

- League coordinator Joe Taylor has over 7 years of fall baseball league coordination experience.
- 10 game league schedule plus playoffs.
- League provided schedule limiting travel while making sure teams are playing different competition than they see during the HS season and summer ball.
- Separate divisions for "Academy/Club" teams and single school based teams.
- Games begin Sunday September 11th - after Labor Day Weekend.
- 3 baseballs provided for every game pre-assigned and handed out at coaches meeting. No traveling to pick up baseballs.
- Certified, 2 man crew PBUA umpires used every game.
- League website with schedules, scores, highlights, updates, and more.
- Discounts for providing home fields for the league.
- League is designed for pre-formed teams, but individuals are welcome and will be placed on a team.

Team Registration Fees

Team Signup - A team is defined as a group of 10 or more players and a coach. There are 3 team fee options:

- Team Fee with 2 Fields Provided - \$1000
- Team Fee with 1 Field Provided - \$1100
- Team Fee with 0 Field Provided - \$1250

All teams must wear matching team uniforms with numbers. Hats and jerseys can be purchased through PBC for an additional fee.

Your registration paperwork is due as soon as you can send it in. There is no drop dead date for individual signups but there is a drop dead date of August 31st for team signups. For any questions, contact Joe Taylor.

The **Portland Baseball Club Fall Instructional Program** for ages 13-18 will give you the opportunity to meet your off season goals. You do not become better baseball players just by playing games. Players must perform actions properly over and over again to build habits that become second nature come game time.

Our Fall Instructional Program will give you the opportunity to work on positional skill work during the week and then play weekend games to implement those skills. Players will be exposed to PBC instruction on hitting, pitching, infield, outfield, and catching mechanics during the week and then provided game situations to reinforce those skills.



Infielders - Tuesdays from 6:00-7:00pm

Outfielders - Tuesdays from 7:00-8:00pm

Pitchers - Wednesdays from 6:00-7:00pm

Catchers - Wednesdays from 7:00-8:00pm

Each session is position specific and will include skill work for each position for 30 minutes followed by 30 minutes of hitting stations. Every player will be given instruction in small groups and lots of repetitions to build good baseball habits. All training is done at the Portland Baseball Club Facility located at 9898 SW Tigard Street, Tigard, OR 97223.

Each Sunday players will be split into teams and play in the PBC Fall League against other teams from Portland and Vancouver. Games will be played as doubleheaders at high school and college fields around the Portland/Vancouver area.

Training begins on Tuesday August 30th. Sunday games begin on September 11th.

Teams divided 7th-9th grade and 10th-12th grade

Cost is \$200 per player

Cost includes training, 10 games plus playoffs, hat, and jersey
